

A program designed to increase Exit Velocity, train to drive the ball consistently and be well educated on approach. This program is fueled with an environment full of competition.

What Tools Are Used?

- Weighted Bats
- Plyo Balls
- Hit Trax
- 960fps camera to break down swings
- Live At-Bats

Axe Bat Training



Main objective of these bats is to create a consistent and efficient swing, giving the player a greater chance in being more successful during games.

How Do the Bats and Balls Help?

Overload End Load: Swinging the end loaded heavy bat helps the hitter learn how to adjust and stay short to the baseball. (This helps flaw such as casting out)

Overload Hand Load: Hand load bat is heavy at the knob. This helps in maximizing barrel whip through the desired swing plane of the hitter. (Helps in flaws of rolling over)

Underload: the lightest of the three. The focus of this bat is to maximize hand "bat" speed through the hitting zone. (everyone loves this bat)

Plyo Balls: Weighted balls main objective is to increase Exit Velocity (how hard the ball comes of the bat), distance and consistent backspin on the ball.

How Much Will It Cost?

The program is available in different packages (program recommends 3-5 days a week):

- \$225 per month, 4 Days
- \$200 per month, 3 Days
- \$185 per month, 2 Days

(This program is baseball and softball, recommended for ages 10+)
